

# ANALSACULECTOMY

## PRE OPERATIVE - MASS

To streamline the referral process the following treatments should be performed at the primary veterinary office and sent to CRAH via email/fax:

- CBC, Chemistry panel, Electrolyte panel
- Ionized Calcium
- Thoracic radiographs
- Abdominal Ultrasound

## PRE OPERATIVE - CHRONIC RUPTURE

To streamline the referral process the following treatments can be performed at the primary veterinary office:  
CBC, Chemistry panel, Electrolyte panel

## POST OPERATIVE

These patients will be discharged from CRAH at 5:30p and should not require overnight hospitalization.

These patients will be discharged with the following:

- Hard sided E-collar
- Gabapentin for 5-7 days
- NSAID's for 2 weeks

These can be filled in advance by the primary veterinarian and sent with the transferring patient to CRAH.

## RECHECKS

We recommend a post-op recheck in 10-14 days with patient's primary veterinarian.
